Registration opens at 8:00 AM and will close 30 minutes before each race. Day of race entry \$5 extra. **One-day licenses may be purchased onsite for \$10 and are valid for a single day of racing. Onsite One-day licenses may only be purchased by Category 5 Men and Women, for use in races open to those categories.** Additional Races subtract \$5 (Does not include comp entries). Course description: 3 lane, purpose built cycling course with four corners and slight rise. Concessions will be available at the race. Race results by Speed Sport Timing. Neutral support by SRAM Race Support. USAC Event Pending. For Junior races, boys and girls will ride together and be scored separately. Note 1: \$10 per rider will be put into the prize list up to \$250. \* Both elite men and women will have podium at the start/finish line after the women's elite race is over. Prize distribution will take place after podium ceremony, you **must** be present to get your prize. I will be looking for podium men/ladies for the appropriate ceremony, proper clothing and decorum required. See me to volunteer.
