

Athletes Code of Conduct

1. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are permitted in the possession of athletes.
2. Behavior on and off the competition field by any persons associated with the Games must follow the highest standards.
3. Use of foul or abusive language constitutes a violation of the Code of Conduct.
4. All athletes must respect the decisions of the officials and umpires during and after competitions. Any harassment will constitute a violation of the Code of Conduct.
5. Unruly behavior by spectators towards players, coaches, volunteers, and/or officials will not be tolerated. Such behavior may result in the dismissal of the offending spectator from the competition site.
6. Any participant's behavior deemed in violation of the Code of conduct, as decided by the Nutmeg State Games administrative staff, subjects the competitor to expulsion from the Games.
