WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE

In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way, including travel to and from, the 2022 Nutmeg State Games Judo Tournament, related events and activities of United States Judo, Inc. (USA JUDO), Middletown High School, Middletown Public Schools, U.S.J.F., The American Traditional Jujutsu Association (ATJA), Shufu Yudanshakai, Dollamur, Tournament Director, Tournament Organizers, Tournament Staff, Local Organizing Committee, and Connecticut Judo, Inc., I hereby:

- Acknowledge that I am familiar with the sport of Judo and understand the rules governing the sport of Judo.
- Agree that prior to participating, I will inspect the mats, equipment, facilities, competition pools or divisions and the elimination or scoring system to be used, and if I believe anything is unsafe or beyond my capability, I will immediately advise my coach, supervisor, and/or a tournament official of such conditions and refuse to participate.
- Acknowledge and fully understand that I will be engaging in a contact sport that might result in serious injury, including permanent disability or death, including possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases (including but not limited to COVID-19, and severe social and economic losses due to not only my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also to the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of the sport of Judo, or conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Further, I acknowledge that there may be other risks not known to me or not reasonably foreseeable at this time.
- Knowing the risks involved in the sport of Judo, I assume all such risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages caused by, arising out of, resulting from or following such injury, permanent disability, or death. I understand that should I elect for myself or my child to participate in a weight or age category outside of his/her "true" weight/age and/or in a category with a significant weight disparity, that the risk of injury, permanent disability or death could be increased.
- Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the 2022 Nutmeg State Games Judo Tournament, related events and activities of United States Judo, Inc. (USA JUDO), Middletown High School, Middletown Public Schools, Dollamur, Tournament Director, Tournament Organizers, Tournament Staff, Local Organizing Committee, and Connecticut Judo, Inc., the United States Judo, Inc., the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee, United States Judo Federation, United States Judo Association, The American Traditional Jujutsu Association (ATJA), together with their affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees or volunteers of the organization, event officials, medical personnel, other participants, their parents, guardians, supervisors and coaches, sponsoring agent
- cies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners, lessors, and lessees of premises used to conduct the event, all of whom are hereinafter referred to as "releasee", from any and all claims, demands, losses, actions, causes of actions or damages on account of injury, including permanent disability and death and possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases (including but not limited to COVID-19, and damage to property (Collectively, "Liabilities"), caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the acts or omissions of the releasee, even if arising from their negligence, OR OTHERWISE to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- I understand and agree that I may be drug tested at any time, that I am subject to and will abide by the USADA Protocol for Olympic and Paralympic Movement Testing, its Annexes, and the USOPC National Anti-Doping Policies, and that any dispute related to the foregoing will be resolved exclusively in arbitration pursuant to the USADA Protocol. Before taking any medications, check the prohibited status at GlobalDRO.com. - I agree to be filmed and photographed under conditions approved and authorized by USA Judo, to include the use of my name, biographical information, public appearances, interviews, photographs, portrait and motion pictures and television recordings of my judo performance/participation and grant to USA Judo and Organizers the right to record and make use of the same, and to authorize others to do so in promoting the competition and the success of the judo team on which I compete, to promote the image of USA Judo, its sponsors and advertisers, and the sport of amateur judo, and to fund the activities of the USA Judo.
- MAAPP Policy: The Center for Safe Sport has developed the Minor Athlete Prevention Policies (MAAPP) which USA Judo has adapted to our own sport. The MAAPP is a collection or proactive and training policies comprised of two parts: Education & Training Policy that requires training for certain Adult Participants and the Required Prevention Policies, focused on limiting on-on-one interactions between Adult Participants and Minor Athletes to prevent abuse.
