## Important Event Notes:

- Held under USA Cycling Permit #: pending
- USA Cycling Race License Required. One-day licenses may be purchased onsite for \$10 and are valid for a single day of racing for Category 5 (novice) Men and Women only for use in races open to those categories. Annual Race License available at USACycling.org.
- Warming Up. It is recommended that riders warm up on trainers or rollers. All roads outside the park are open to traffic and riders assume their own risk when warming up on open roads.
- Online registration at <u>www.bikereg.com</u>. Online surcharges apply.
- Day of registration will be \$10 additional. Each additional race \$15.
- Fees will increase \$5 after May 23. (except juniors)
- Cash or check only on "day of" entries.
- Entry Fee includes USA Cycling Insurance Surcharge of \$5.30
- All field sizes limited to 125 riders, with following the exception: Cat 5 (Novice) Men, Cat 4/5 (Novice) Women, 60+ Masters and all Junior fields have a field limit of 75 riders.
- Online registration closes 6/8/23 at 5 PM. Day of registration closes 30 minutes prior to start of each race.
- Nutmeg State Games Medals and Podium awarded to top 3 Finishers of all listed races as well as 45-49, 50-54 and 55-59 age divisions in the 45+ Men's & Women's races
- CT State Championship medals and Podium awarded to: Elite Men (CAT 1-2-3) ~ Elite Women (CAT 1-2-3) ~ U23 from Elite categories ~ Men's Masters 45+ & 65+ ~ Women's 45+ as well as the 45-49, 50-54 and 55-59 age division in the 45+ Men's & Women's races. Only CT residents eligible for state medals and must hold an annual license.
- Professional riders are welcome to compete but are NOT eligible for State Championship medals
- Junior Boys and Girls will ride together and be scored separately. 15-18 yrs who are cat 1-3 should race in women's/men's 123 races in the afternoon. Junior races are part of the CCAP/Matthew Waskiewicz Junior Road Race Series
- Women's cat 4/5 race is part of the Southern New England Women's Developmental Series. Masters 60+ men and Masters 45+ women will race at same time (1:15PM) with separate starts and is open to CAT's 1-5
- Women's Cat 3 will race for points and a \$300 Prize pool. Women's Pro 1-2-3: will race for CT State Championship Title and \$600 prize pool. Riders are eligible to win any prime announced during this race regardless of category. Combined field limit total: 125
- Masters 45+ scheduled for 12:15 PM is open to CAT 1-4 riders only. Neutral Support pending. For more information 860-539-6996, or email: <a href="mailto:nutmeg@csmg.org">nutmeg@csmg.org</a>
